- Tuition rates cover entire 6 week session. These are not “per week” rates.
- \$10 Registration fee is non refundable. Pay only 1 registration fee per family.
- Students may change classes between Winter/Spring sessions
- **Payment is due at time of registration.**
- Registration with payment is due by **April 19.**
- NO refunds/credits for Spring session withdraws after **April 19.**

Location

- All of these classes will be held in our new home at **420 Bank St.** Downtown Norfolk. (Located on the corner of St. Paul’s Blvd. & Charlotte St. across from Scope/ Chrysler Hall) Parking is available in nearby garages: either the Scope Parking Garage or MacArthur Center Mall Garage. Communication

- The primary means of communication with our Hurrah families is through a private web site called “MyFamily” This site is for Hurrah students and parents to access information about our relocation, class schedules, audition information and rehearsals. Please provide a legible email on the registration form so you can receive a password to this site. Your password will be sent via email “invite”.

Attendance

- Classes meet once a week on the scheduled day (Except Short Scene Production)
- **The final day of each class (the week of May 17 - 22) is “show and tell” day. Parents are invited to attend class with their child to see demonstrations of what the class has been working on.**
- All classes require a minimum number of enrolled students. Any class with less than the minimum requirement will be terminated. In such case, you will be notified and refunded or credited for the remaining classes.
- Students, please attend all your classes and be on time. Parents, please remember we are not responsible for children before or after class time.
- Short Scene Production Class
- This class meets TWICE a week but tuition is same as once a week class.

Auditions

- All registered students are eligible to audition. Auditions are by appointment only. Those auditioning are asked to sing karaoke style (accompanied by music only. CD MUST NOT have lyrics on it) Must be available for rehearsals and all performances
- **Rugrats** auditions are Saturday March 27 in the afternoon. Please call the Hurrah office 627-5437 to schedule an audition.
- Additional audition & performance opportunities will be announced to registered students.
